

Care and Cleaning

Possible Problems	Recommendation
Dirt & Grime	Sweep with a whisk or high pressure water hose.
Oil & Grease Stains	Rinse stains and scrub with household degreaser. Use fine sandpaper and sand lightly.
Ink	Ink stains may be permanent. They may be lightened by cleaning with household detergent and warm water.
Ice & Snow	Apply calcium chloride or rock salt; use a plastic shovel to avoid gouging the surface. Later rinse deck to prevent surface residue build up.
Mold & Mildew	Periodically cleaning your deck to prevent the build up of pollen, dirt and grime, even if the deck appears clean. Clean mold/ mildew with a deck cleaner containing bleach water and detergent. WPC products are formulated to inhibit mildew growth and minimize staining, but maintaining clean, dry deck surface is the best method of combating mold and mildew.
For Daily Maintenance	1:99 diluted household bleach can be used on surface of WPC, then rinse the surface thoroughly with water and wipe dry is needed.
